Elbow Park School is hosting a Parent Information Evening on Thursday, February 5, 2026 starting at 6:00 p.m. There will be a short presentation in the Library (Learning Commons) hosted by our Administration and Kindergarten staff. We will highlight the various components of the Kindergarten program and this will be followed by a tour of the school and the Kindergarten space. Due to the presentation format and length, **this presentation is designed only for parents / guardians**. We will hold a separate Student Orientation Session in the spring when you are encouraged to bring your child to experience the inside of a Kindergarten classroom.

This presentation is for parents & guardians of children eligible to attend Kindergarten in the fall of 2026. **Children must be at least five years old as of December 31 to start kindergarten in the fall of that calendar year.** This means that a four-year old child may start kindergarten if they will turn five on or before December 31 of that calendar year. **Priority will be given to families who live in our attendance area boundary and who are resident to the CBE public board of education.**

Registration is **NOT** on a first-come-first-served basis. If registration numbers warrant having a morning and afternoon class, a lottery will be held to determine class lists.
